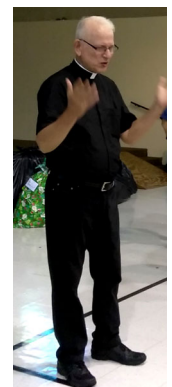
Christmas Masses
